## ELIGIBILITY AND SPECIFICATIONS

The Poetic Justice III Show is open to members and non-members of the AAOC. Any artwork accepted into a previous AAOC juried competition is ineligible. Work must be original and have been completed within the past three years.

ENTRY FEE: \$20 Checks payable to AAOC

**SUBMISSION:** Art images should be sent in the form of a digital photo. Deadline for entries is September 30, 2010. Mail or email photo disc or USB, with completed entry form and fee to:

**DELIVERY:** Accepted artwork must be delivered to the AAOC, Gallery 104 on October 3, 2010 from 1-4 pm.

**SPECIFICATIONS:** Art on canvas must be spray sealed if gallery-wrapped. If canvas is stapled on sides, it must be framed. Paintings, photographs, and drawings which are not on canvas, must be framed and covered with glass or Plexiglas. Framed art shall have multi-stranded wire appropriately and securely attached to frame. Loose ends of wire shall be taped to prevent scraping walls. Textile art and other hanging art must have the appropriate hanger for support. Arrangements must be made for hanging artwork exceeding 35 lbs (unsuitable for wall-hanging system). Three-dimensional artwork shall include appropriate display stand or pedestal for exhibit.
